of Innovation Management Global MBA Program 2022 Enrollment Information for Non-degree Students

Those who wish to take courses at this graduate school are permitted to take courses as "non-degree students" after a screening process, provided there is sufficient class capacity, according to Article 47 of the Professional Graduate Schools Regulations. Non-degree students may only take courses on which regular students are registered.

- 2 Number of credits that can be taken: Up to 20 credits per year
 - * Article 6 of the Graduate School Non-degree student Regulations is not applicable.
 - ※ Please note that the following courses are not available for enrollment: Project1-A, Project1-B, Project2-A, Project2-B, Strategic Organizational Management Multinational Business I and II, Business Practice in Japan
 - * Enrollment for non-degree students may also be restricted for courses other than the aforementioned ones, depending on the enrollment status of the regular students taking the course.
- 3 Application period:
 - (1) March 15 (Tue)-March 22 (Tue), 2022 (Registration for courses starting in the spring semester only)
 - (2) June 21 (Tue)—June 28 (Tue), 2022 (Registration for courses starting in the summer intensive period only)
 - (3) July 26 (Tue)—August 2 (Tue), 2022 (Registration for courses starting in the fall semester only)

- 5 Qualifications for application:

Applicants must satisfy the following qualifications "a"-"c."

- a. Professional qualifications (any one of the following as of April 1, 2022):
 - [1] Generally, those who have at least three-year's **fulltime** work experience (**excluding part-time jobs**) at private companies, government agencies, public interest corporations or similar, in Japan or overseas countries.
 - [2] Those who have a professional qualification determined in a qualifications screening by the HOSEI Business School of Innovation Management as equivalent or superior to a minimum of three-year's **fulltime** work experience (**excluding part-time jobs**).
- b. Academic qualifications (any one of the following)
 - [1] Those who have graduated from a 4-year university course in Japan or abroad, or those who are expected to graduate by the end of March 2022.
 - [2] Those who have completed 16 years of school education abroad or those who are expected to complete it by the end of March 2022.
 - [3] Those who have completed a correspondence course offered in Japan by a foreign school that is equivalent to a 16-year educational curriculum in that country or expected to complete it by the end of March 2022.
 - [4] Those who have been admitted by the qualifications screening to have academic ability equivalent to or more than university graduates at the HOSEI Business School of Innovation Management and are over 22 years old.

- * Those who have not acquired bachelor's degree (including those applicants of spring semester who are expected to acquire it by the end of March 2022, and those applicants of fall semester who are expected to acquire it by the end September 2022) are not applicable.
- c. English language ability (any one of the following)
 - [1] TOEIC® score of 740 or higher
 - [2] TOEFL® score of 81 (internet-based), 553 (paper-based) or higher
 - [3] IELTS AcademicTM score of 6.0 or higher

However, those for whom 1) or 2) below is applicable are not required to submit their TOEFL, IELTS or TOEIC transcript.

- 1) Those whose mother language is English and who have lived and been educated in the country where English is an official language.
- 2) Those whose mother language is not English but who have completed an undergraduate or higher educational program offered in English. (Applicants must submit documents that certify the relevant university program is offered in English.)
- * If you are interested in having qualifications screening, please contact us for the spring semester by Monday, March 7, for the summer intensive period by the end of April, and for the fall semester by the end of June.

6 Application documents:

- (1) Application form (use the Form 1)
- (2) Resume (use the Form 2)
- (3) Student certificate of eligibility (original document of graduation certificate or similar)
- (4) Academic transcript* (original document. For a graduate in Master Course is required to submit transcripts of Bachelor Degree and Master Degree)
- (5) Your face photo (borderless, one; Attach 4 cm \times 3 cm, photo to the resume)
- (6) Certificate of residence (issued within 3 months of application, not containing your "My Number" ID number)
- (7) Certificate of degree completion (Submission required <u>only for those who have graduated from a university in a country other than Japan.</u>)
- (8) A copy of official TOEIC®, TOEFL® or IELTS Academic™ score certificate (issued in or after September 2020)
- Note 1: Graduates of this graduate school are exempted from the submission of documents that are marked with an asterisk (*).
- Note 2: If you wish to enroll more than once within the same year, you can omit the documents other than the application form during the second time you apply.

7 Notes on application

- (1) For those applicants who do not meet academic or professional qualification at the time of application, but were accepted to take courses as non-degree students, the permission will be revoked when they cannot satisfy qualifications before the date of enrollment.
- (2) If fraud is discovered after receiving permission to study as a non-degree student and the permission is revoked by the university, registration fee and course fee once paid cannot be refunded to an applicant.

8 Tuition fees:

(1) Registration fee

10,000 yen

- * You only need to pay registration fee once even if you wish to take more than two courses within the same year.
- * You only need to pay the registration fee once even if you wish to take more than two courses in other majors within the same year.
- * Graduates who have majored in Innovation Management are exempted from the registration fee.
- (2) Course fee (for one course [two credits]): 150,000 yen; (one course [four credits]: 300,000 yen)
 - * Graduates who have majored in Innovation Management pay half of the above amounts.

9 Permission to study and payment of course fees:

Those applying for the spring semester courses will be notified as to whether their applications were successful in <u>late April</u>; those applying for summer intensive courses will be notified in <u>late July</u>; and notifications regarding fall semester courses will be sent in <u>late September</u>. Notifications will be sent to the current address listed on the

resume. If you have been accepted to take the course, please use the designated form for bank transfers within the period specified in the permission to study notification.

- **X** Please attend classes from the first lecture onward regardless of whether you have or don't have a permission to study from the HOSEI Business School of Innovation Management.
- * Date of enrollment for spring admission is April 1, and for fall admission is September 16.

10 Issuance of accreditation of credits and certificates:

Non-degree students can take exams for the courses they have opted. If you pass the exams, you will be certified as having taken the courses (credits), and we will issue a certificate upon your request.

11 Visas for international students:

When applying as a foreign student to the non-degree students system of this graduate school, students must generally have a visa that allows them to stay or renew their stay in Japan for a period longer than the period they are enrolled in this university as a non-degree student (until the end of September 2022 for the spring semester and until the end of March 2023 for the fall semester).

Please be noted that this graduate school will not enable students to acquire a study abroad visa even for those accepted as non-degree students for either of the following reasons:

- ① Non-degree students may apply for up to 20 credits at this graduate school, but if, as a result of individual examination of a prospective student, permission to take one or more courses is not granted, a student cannot study "10 hours or more per week" (six or more courses) as stipulated in the "Ministry Ordinance to Establish Criteria for the Immigration Control and Refugee Recognition Act, Article 7, Section 1, Item 2" (Ministry of Justice Ordinance), then a student visa cannot be obtained (or renewed).
- ② Even if all the courses applied for are approved, all of our admission procedures will be completed by early May for the spring semester, by early August for the summer intensive period, and by early October for the fall semester. It will then take approximately from one to two months from the visa application until the visa issuance, and the student visa will expire at the end of each semester when classes end.

12 Approval of credits after admission:

If you are enrolled at the HOSEI Business School of Innovation Management, up to 20 credits completed as a non-degree student can be regarded as credits for the HOSEI Business School of Innovation Management. However, while the 20 credits will be evaluated as R (accredited) and converted to completion credits, they will not be eligible for GPA or scholarship assessment.
