<p>[学生へのメッセージ]</p> <p>Accounting is the language of business. It is the process of recording, classifying, and summarizing economic events through financial statements and communicates the companies' financial information to external parties such as investors and creditors. The transparent accounting information is essential for the companies to finance their business activities from the capital market.</p> <p>In the class, after studying the basic accounting theory, we will study how to prepare the financial statements including bookkeeping procedures and provide the analysis on the accounting information in the financial statements. We also discuss how to provide the solution in the complicated accounting issues in practice. Through the course, I would expect you to improve your understanding about accounting theory and practice, and build the ability to prepare the financial statements and provide the analysis on the accounting information.</p>
