It involves the process of recording, classifying, and summarizing economic events through financial statements, which communicate a company's financial and economic information to external parties such as investors and creditors. Transparent accounting information is essential for companies to secure funding for their business activities from the capital market.</p> <p>In this course, after studying basic accounting theory, we will explore how to prepare financial statements, including bookkeeping procedures, and analyze the accounting information presented in these statements. We will also discuss solutions to complex accounting issues encountered in practice.</p> <p>Throughout the course, I expect you to enhance your understanding of accounting theory and practice, develop the ability to prepare accounting information, and provide insightful analyses of that information. Additionally, we will explore the potential opportunities for using AI in accounting.</p>
